



## Halloween Guidelines

On Friday, October 30, you will be allowed to dress up for Halloween. There are specific guidelines that you must follow if you choose to dress up

- Costumes must follow the “Non-Uniform Dress Code”
  - Skirts or dresses cannot be shorter than 2 inches from the crease in the back of the knee.
  - Tops/blouses/shirts/sweaters/dresses cannot be low-cut, form-fitting, see-through, halter, strapless, spaghetti-straps, bare midriff, bare-back, cut-out or otherwise inappropriate
  - Shoes must cover more than half of the foot and cannot be backless or have a heel higher than 2 inches
  - Leggings are ok so long as skirt/shorts of appropriate length are worn over
- Costumes must be in good taste and reflect the image of Mission
  - Nothing bloody or gory/gruesome
  - You cannot dress up like a faculty or staff member
  - Weapons cannot be a part of your costume
  - No Bodysuits (i.e. catwoman)
  - No Dressing up like a student from another school.
- If you violate any of these guidelines you will be sent home
